

Board of Directors of DC Green Bank Meeting Minutes of Board Meeting #2021.06.03.RBO Thursday, June 3, 2021 10:06am – 10:28am

A meeting of the Board of Directors of DC Green Bank was held on **Thursday**, **June 3**, **2021** via teleconference.

1. Call to order and verification of quorum

DC Green Bank Board Chair, Brandi Colander, called the meeting to order at 10:06am. Ms. Colander asked Mr. Ed Hubbard to verify a quorum. With five (5) voting members present, the Board had a quorum and the meeting continued.

2. Approval of the Minutes from Board Meeting #2021.04.15.RBO

A motion was made to approve the minutes from the April 15, 2021 regular Board meeting by Mr. Nogueira. The motion was seconded by Ms. Colander. After a roll call vote, the motion passed (5-0-0).

4. Committee Updates

CEO Hopson provided updates on DC Green Banks community impact, financials, and stakeholder outreach. Mr. Hopson also provided an update on the Flywheel project, highlighting the fact that the project had created 19 jobs to date.
