





OVERVIEW OF DCGB PROJECTS AND IMPACT



First National Baptist Church

- DCGB Investment: \$69K, Total Project: \$115K
- Projected Impacts:
 - \$10,700 annual utility savings
 - Partnership with City First Enterprises

Walker Memorial Baptist Church

- DCGB Investment: \$415K
- Projected Impacts:
 - \$10,000 annual utility savings
 - \$30,000 solar renewable energy credits

Copernican Energy

- DCGB Investments: \$500K and \$192K
 - Investments for solar at nearly 30 DC properties
- Projected Impacts
 - Cut residents' utility bills by at least 50%
 - Majority in Wards 7 & 8
 - One investment in partnership with City First Enterprises (\$128k invested)

INVESTMENT HIGHLIGHTS

Barry Farm - The Edmonson

- DCGB Investment: \$3M, Total Project Size: \$134M
- Projected Impacts:
 - 139 units of permanently affordable housing
 - Energy efficient geothermal heat pump lowers GHG emissions

Ridgecrest Phase 2

- DCGB Investment: \$2.25M, Total Project Size: \$47M
- Projected Impacts:
 - 128 units of newly permanent affordable housing
 - Full electrification, improved HVAC system

Cycle House

- DCGB Investment: \$2M, Total Project Size: \$13M
- Projected Impacts:
 - 18 affordable homes
 - Net-zero energy use

Emblem

- DCGB Investment: \$3M, Total Project Size: \$111M
- Projected Impacts:
 - 115 units of permanently affordable housing
 - Enterprise Green Communities Certification Plus

DC PACE UPDATE

DC

GB

- Since its creation, the DC PACE Program has financed more than \$100 million in green building upgrades.
- DC PACE Impacts:
 - Created more than 1000 jobs
 - Save property owners and residents nearly \$160 million
- In FY24, DC PACE financed \$3.5 million in upgrades.
- PACE Nation recognized Ronald Hobson and the DC PACE Program with an award for program design and implementation.
